



EUROPEAN DANCE TOURS WITH PARADIZO

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQS)

How much spending money should I bring?

Budget for about \$50 - \$100 AUD per day. Ensure that you let your bank know that you are travelling in case you need to take out any cash. We recommend that you exchange some Kunas (Croatian Dollars) / Euro (for Valencia/Benidorm/Barcelona) before leaving Australia.

Will the dance workshops be in English?

Both the SSD + CSSF in Croatia will have all their classes taught in English. The city also has their menus with English translation, so you won't need to worry in Croatia. If your tour goes to Valencia, Benidorm and Barcelona, it will be helpful for you to learn some basics in Spanish, however it is not necessary as Paradizo will be there to help you. Workshops in Benidorm will most likely be in Spanish, so you may not understand everything, but you will be able to follow the class, and you can also ask others around you to help translate. When you go shopping, most shop attendants in Spain speak English.

Do I need travel insurance?

Yes, travel insurance is mandatory. We recommend purchasing it from the date you leave Australia to the day you arrive back in Australia.

Do I need a visa?

Citizens of the U.K., EU countries, the U.S., Canada, Australia and New Zealand did not (and do not) need visas to visit Croatia. Visitors can visit Croatia for up to 90 days in any 180 day period. If you are not a citizen of U.K., EU countries, the U.S., Canada, Australia and New Zealand, you will have to get a visa, please ensure you have a visa if you require one. This will not be our responsibility to complete this for you.

What if I want to arrive earlier/ stay later on the tour?

You are more than welcome to arrive earlier/stay later, however all accommodation and travel arrangements must be made by yourself.

What is the bedding situation for accommodation?

All accommodation in the tours are twin share. For Croatia, they will be either single beds or double beds. Sharing will be organised through Paradizo trying to pair up friends (if possible), if not, you will be placed with another participant. Where possible, Paradizo will try to arrange the best accommodation arrangement based on your preferences, however please note, if it's not possible, you will have to be flexible in who you are sharing a room with. If you would like a single room to yourself, you will have to pay for 2 people in accommodation fees (please speak to Paradizo if you would like to arrange this)* this option is only available for Valencia/Benidorm/Barcelona, not Croatia.

What should I pack?

It will be summer, and we will be dancing! Ensure to bring, all your beach accessories, dance shoes and dance gear, clothes for parties, light summery clothes for during the day, light jacket for the night time. We also recommend for you to bring medication in case you get sick, sun screen protection, insect repellent, deodorant, beach towel, powerboard to charge more devices, adaptor, locks and keys for bag security.
